

# School Safety Is a Priority

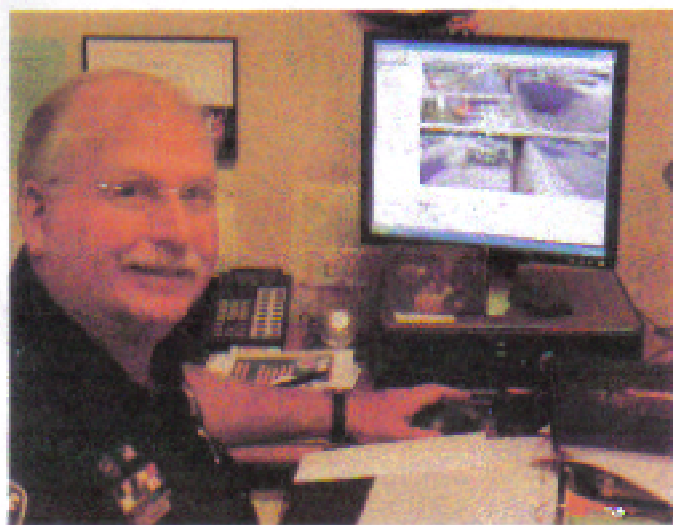
"Parents, students and teachers can be assured that school safety is a priority in our school district," Superintendent Stacey Bryce announced during the August meeting of the school board. A new security camera system was installed on the middle and high school campuses this summer and a School Resource Officer, Deputy Wayne Burgess, was assigned to Sabine ISD from the Gregg County Sheriff's Office.

The business-grade security cameras were installed by 3D Security, an area company that specializes in business applications, includ-

ing schools and banks. The cameras allow administrators to monitor parking lots, hallways, and other areas all at once or individually. The cameras also operate around-the-clock and

provide high-quality color video even when the school day ends.

Deputy Burgess will provide services that are regularly assigned to licensed peace officers. The advantage of having him on campus is that response time will be quicker. He will also work with the campuses on crime prevention and other security measures.
